The Lent course begins on Thursday 17th March 7.00 – 9.00 p.m. it carries on for five weeks. The evenings are as follows:

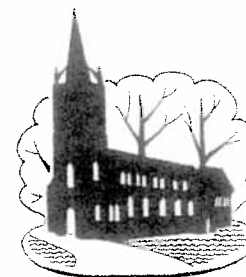
- Saviour - Talk by Tim Wright

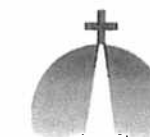
### Prayer of the month
